- ✓ Qualification must be issued no more than 4 years ago

### WORKING CONDITIONS

- Farming in Germany has a minimum of 40 working hours per week. Trainees are paid for any overtime worked. This is not a holiday farm; trainees must expect to put in effort. Accommodation is organized by the employer and costs approximately 250€/month.

## EARNINGS / ALLOWANCE

- Remuneration varies depending on the position. We cannot negotiate minimum wage. The minimum allowance is approximately 1702 €/month after taxes.

## COSTING

Agriculture Program Cost: 2100 Euros

Applications take 6 – 12 months to process. The cost includes:

- Processing costs in South Africa and abroad
- Health insurance application assistance
- VISA
- Accommodation assistance
- Flight ticket
- Emergency services throughout the internship abroad

## APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Apply: Send your CV to [ruralreachglobal23@gmail.com](mailto:ruralreachglobal23@gmail.com)
2. Screening: Our consultant will assess your eligibility and explain the process.
3. Registration: Make registration payments and complete all required documents.
4. Submission: We submit your application to partners and arrange interviews.
5. Placement: Once placed, partners prepare your visa documentation.
6. Visa and Flights: Visa processing takes 1–3 months. Once granted, we book your flight.

Application process takes 3–12 months.
